Election of the Lord Mayor 29th September 2014

The election of the Lord Mayor will take place on Monday 29th September.

The Silent Ceremony 7th November (Friday)

The Silent Ceremony is where the outgoing Lord Mayor (Fiona Woolf) hands over 'The Lord Mayors's Hat' (supplied by the Feltmakers' Company) to the incoming Lord Mayor. Dating back hundreds of years it takes place in Guildhall watched by Aldermen, the City Officers, Masters of Livery Companies and several hundred liverymen the day before the Lord Mayor's show.

The Lord Mayor-elect swears the oath of office then dons his tricorn hat at the precise moment the outgoing mayor will remove hers - the hat symbolising the official transfer of the mayoralty and the power that accompanies it. Some tickets are available via the Clerk.

This year, Alderman Alan Yarrow is in line to to be the next Lord Mayor; this means that one of our Feltmakers, namely Assistant Gilly Yarrow, will be the next Lady Mayoress. To mark this special occasion the Company will be entering a float in this years show. The Feltmakers last entered a float in the show some ten years ago as part of our quatercentenary celebrations.

The Company float will consist of 3 vintage cars which will carry 15 students from the Royal Ballet School. They will wear costumes from their own ballet La Destinée and hats designed by millinery students from Kensington and Chelsea College. There are 15 millinery students on the course, which fits perfectly with the requirement for 15 hats for the dancers. A contingent of former officers from our affiliated frigate HMS Lancaster, along with cadets from HMS Collingwood will also be in the parade wearing No1 uniforms. Liverymen from the Feltmakers' Company will participate in the float as passengers in the vehicles and walkers in the parade. The intention is that they will wear tricorn hats with feathers. Carol Service — 10th December 2014

The Carol Service will be held on 10th December (Wednesday) at St. Bartholomew the Great followed by supper at Haberdashers Hall. It is one of London's oldest churches. Founded in 1123 as an Augustinian Priory, it has been in continuous use since 1143. The Priory was dissolved in 1539 and the nave of the Church was demolished. The monastic buildings were largely intact and the Canons' choir and sanctuary were preserved for parish use.

Under Queen Mary, there was briefly a house of Dominican friars here, before it reverted to being a Parish Church under Queen Elizabeth I. Various parts of the building were damaged or destroyed through the centuries until the restoration began in the 19th century, first in the 1860s and then, under Sir Aston Webb, in the 1880s and 90s and on into the 20th century.

Inter-Livery Skiing 23-24 January 2015 - Morzine

The Inter Livery Ski Championships is entering its 6th year. In the first five years we have seen over 400 liverymen and women, freemen and women from 40 livery companies have entered teams, but not yet the Feltmakers. Feltmakers, why not form a team for 2015?

The Ironmongers' Company is pleased to announce that the annual inter livery ski championships will take place in Morzine, Portes du Soleil, France on 23rd and 24th January 2015. All livery companies are invited to send a team of 3 or 4 individual members of their Company who may be liverymen/women, freemen/women, apprentices, journeymen/women etc. to race in slalom and giant slalom events to be held over two days. Each company would be responsible for their individual travel arrangements and accommodation for the event.

Entries will close on 1st January 2015 and will be limited to 150 on a 'first come first served basis.' Priority will be given to those who attended previous Championships.



The aim is to encourage every skier, whatever their ability and age, to compete and the courses will be set accordingly. This is an opportunity for those liverymen and women who are not always able to be involved in their Company's affairs to represent their own company in a unique event held not only outside the Square Mile but even outside their own Country!

This is an opportunity to get to know members of your own company better and also meet members of other livery companies. We have made arrangements with the tourist office for help with accommodation. We will do everything possible to keep the costs low in order to encourage as many younger liverymen and women as possible to be involved. We hope to raise money from the event for the Lord Mayor's Appeal and other charities.
